Documentation Requirements for Academic or Housing Accommodations for Physical Disabilities

Students with physical disabilities who require consideration for academic or housing accommodations through Cedarville University Disability Services should submit the electronic application (Cedarville.edu/disabilities) as well as professional documentation from the diagnosing clinician. Documentation must fully support the need for all requested academic or housing accommodations. For medical support please contact University Medical Services.

Documentation must include all of the following information:

- Testing that provides a current picture of the impact of the disability (generally 1-2 years)
- Statement identifying the diagnosis.
- Thorough description of the current functional impact, including any activities of daily living and learning processes that are substantially impacted.
- Explanation of the student's current treatment plan, if applicable.
- Recommendations for housing or academic-related accommodations based on individual need and necessity.
- Contact information, credentials, and signature of the diagnosing professional.
