Can You Appear in Person? NO.

If the student is unable to appear in person to the Cedarville University Financial Aid Office to verify his or her identity, they must choose one of the following options:

- A.** Mail a notarized copy of your unexpired, valid government-issued photo identification (ID) to Cedarville University. Acceptable forms of ID include, but are not limited to, a driver's license, state-issued ID, or passport. **The copy must be made by a notary public. The notary must initial and date the copy. The notary's acknowledgment (below) must accompany the ID copy;** OR
- B.** Schedule a video call with the Cedarville University Financial Aid Office to present your unexpired, valid government-issued photo ID. Acceptable forms of ID include, but are not limited to, a driver's license, state-issued ID, or passport. During the call, an authorized university representative will take a screenshot of your ID. The screenshot will be signed and dated by the representative. This signed screenshot will be securely maintained by the Financial Aid Office.
