- Sign in to myCU.
- Click on Grant Parent Access.
- From this page, your student can grant you select or complete access to finances, financial aid, academic records, and more.

Local parents, come join your students on Cedarville University's campus for an encouraging night of worship with worship leader Matt Papa!


This event is free and open to the public. Be sure to bring your friends and family! This worship night is not one you will want to miss.


