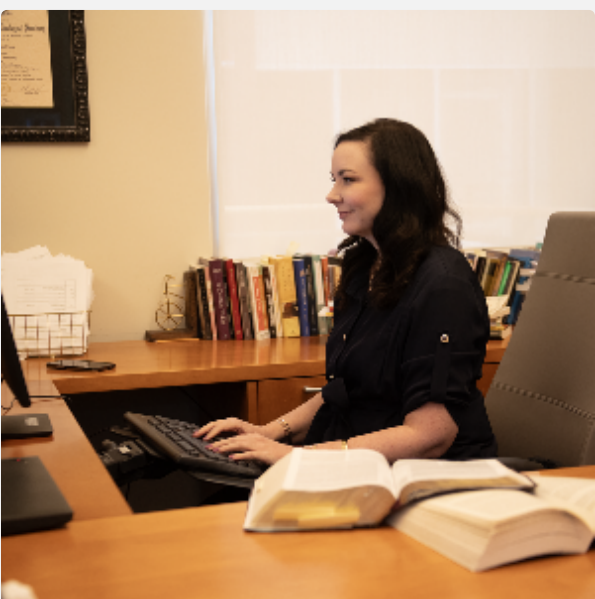

## Has Your Student Signed Up for Spring Courses?

Freshman parents, the course registration window for spring 2026 is coming soon! Most freshman students will receive a suggested course schedule from the Registrar. Students who have sophomore-level credits (31+) or have access to priority registration (through athletics, the honors program, etc.), will need to work with their advisor to plan their spring semester schedule.
