

Pursue an Accelerated Pathway to Your **BSN** Degree

Save time and money by earning early college credit

Cedarville's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) can be completed early through the 30-credit Accelerated BSN Pathway. Students complete the first year of the BSN curriculum through dual enrollment. This requires completing 30 dual credits, including all courses highlighted in gray. Accelerated BSN students must be 18 years old when they begin their first year on campus.

Accelerated BSN Pathway Course Options

The Accelerated BSN Pathway assumes that students will meet undergraduate proficiency requirements for English and math and complete at least two years of the same high school foreign language.
