

Registration Information • Fall Semester 2025



All current students who plan to continue for Fall Semester 2025 should register for classes before leaving campus at the end of Spring Semester 2025.

Undergraduate and Graduate Students

- Confirm your registration date and time through myCU or Student Planning.
- Create your schedule plan in Student Planning.
- Connect with your advisor to discuss your schedule and select course sections.
- Click "Register" to activate your schedule in Student Planning after your registration time opens and after receiving advisor approval.
- Verify that your schedule is accurate in your Student Planning account.



- Classification is determined by the total hours completed at the time of registration.
- Credit hours for Spring 2025 are not included.
- Your specific registration date and time can be found in Student Planning.

 - Classes that are full (starting August 25)
- Prerequisite Waiver
 - O To gain entrance into a course where the prerequisite has not been met yet.

Guidelines

Financial Terms & Conditions Agreement

- All students must complete the Financial Terms and Conditions Agreement before registering for Fall Semester 2025.
- In myCU, search for "Sign Financial Terms and Conditions" and complete the form.

Where do I find course information for Fall Semester?

- Search myCU for "View Undergraduate Course Schedules" or "View Graduate Course Schedules"
- Click link to the Fall 2025 Semester course schedule.

How do I register for regular classes?

- All students use the Student Planning program to register.
- View the helpful tutorials for <u>using Student Planning</u> on the Office of the Registrar's webpage.

How do I access Student Planning?

 In myCU, search for "Register for Classes (Students)— Student Planning."

How do I register for online courses? (Revised)

- Priority registration students, Seniors, and Juniors may register for up to <u>ONE</u> online course through Student Planning on a space available basis up to the end of the Junior registration period.
- After the Junior registration period, all students needing one or more online courses must complete an Online Course Request form. (Available in myCU)

What do I do if a course is full?

- During registration and through August 22, courses that are full will be managed with the waitlist process.
- If a course is full that you would like to take, please add yourself to the waitlist in Student Planning.
- The Office of the Registrar will manage moving students from the waitlist as spots are made available or at a professor's request. Please watch your email for instructions if a spot becomes available for you.
- On Friday, August 22, at 5:00 p.m., the waitlist will be shut off and the Registration Approval Request form will be used.

Self-registration through student planning ends for all students on Friday, August 22, at 5:00 p.m.

Financial Information.

You may view your student account balance and current bill through myCU. Search "View Student Account."

Your first payment is due on **August 4, 2025**. Accounts paid after this time are considered late and are subject to a \$25 late payment penalty.

Your financial aid is reflected on your current student account activity page.

Tuition Block for Undergraduate Students

 Tuition block is 12-17 credits. Additional tuition is charged starting at 17.5 credits.

Payment Methods

- Check: Make your check payable to Cedarville University. Please write seven-digit ID# on check.
- Credit Card: Most major credit cards are accepted with a 2.7% fee.
- Electronic Payment: Go to myCU.cedarville.edu.
 Search for View Student Account/Pay Bill.

Deferred/4-Month Payment* Due Dates:

August 4, *September 1, *October 1, *November 1
 *plus simple interest at 5% annual.

Drop/Add & Refunds -

No tuition refund is applicable for undergraduate students who remain within the block of 12-17 credits.

For other students who qualify, tuition refunds for **16-week courses** will be credited according to the following schedule.
