Townhouse Application



General Information:

- 1. Students living in the townhouses are not required to purchase a meal plan.
- 2. Students living in the townhouses do not have curfew.
- Students living in the townhouses are permitted to stay during all breaks, except Christmas.*
 * Additional charges will apply for students accepted to stay through the summer.
- 4. Students living in the townhouses will be billed per semester.

General Instructions:

- 1. Priority for townhouse selections will be given based on year in school with preference to graduate students.
- 2. Priority will be given to complete applications that fill all the beds in a townhouse for the entire school year (Fall and Spring Semester).
- 3. Disciplinary history may be considered when reviewing applications.
- 4. All individuals in a townhouse group should be listed on one application. The group is responsible for the accuracy of this information.
- 5. Townhouse applications should be submitted by the appropriate deadline for consideration. Changes to the application are not permitted after the deadline.
- 6. Townhouse groups are required to select a student from their group to serve as a coordinator with the residence life office. The coordinator will be responsible to:
 - a. Assist in communication of important residence life information to the residents of the townhouse.
 - b. Encourage the upkeep and cleanliness of the townhouse.
 - c. Submit maintenance work orders on behalf of the residents.
- 7. Townhouse selections will be made prior to the off campus approvals and residence hall housing selection process. If not selected for a townhouse, members of the group will have to apply for off campus permission or select a residence hall room. Once a group accepts approval for living in a townhouse, they relinquish the ability to apply for off campus permission or to select any other residence hall room.
- 8. If at any point a townhouse group member withdraws from the university or moves out of the townhouse, Cedarville residence life reserves the right to assign a new student as a resident in the townhouse or consolidate students without roommates.
- 9. Individuals can forfeit their townhouse spot if they are not registered for classes or have not paid their reservation deposit by May 1.
