# **Avoiding Vague and Ambiguous Pronoun References**

## **VOCABULARY**

#### **Antecedent**

The noun which a pronoun substitutes for or refers to.

#### **Ambiguous Pronoun Reference**

A pronoun with multiple, possible antecedents.

#### **Vaque Pronoun Reference**

A pronoun without a specific antecedent.

## THE RULE

A pronoun must refer to a single noun, which acts as its antecedent.

## **PRACTICE** Fixing Ambiguous Pronoun References

**Error:** When Samuel dropped the goblet onto the glass table, **it** broke. (What broke? The table or the goblet?)

**Correction:** The **goblet** broke when Samuel dropped **it** onto the glass table.

**Error:** Amy had an internship at Dell last summer; **this** will become her career. (What does "this" refer to?)

Correction: Amy had an internship at Dell last summer; this work will become her career.

# PRACTICE Fixing Vague Pronoun References

**Error: They** should increase funding to academic programs. (Who is "they"?)

**Correction: The administration** should increase funding to academic programs.

**Error:** Sleeping eight hours a night is vital to the health of students, yet research clearly shows they simply don't do **it.** (What is the antecedent of "it"?)

**Correction:** Although sleeping eight hours a night is vital to the health of students, research clearly shows they simply don't sleep that much.
